**22/00505/PLF** - Change of use of redundant agricultural building to 3 holiday cottages Land and buildings north of Hornby Farm West End Kilham East Yorkshire YO25 4RR The Parish Council has reservations regarding this planning application and believes clarification is required on the following points:-

- 1. The buildings are referred to as agricultural but due to the length of time they have not been used for such purpose can they still be referred to as agricultural buildings and what is the classification of the land?
- 2. Historically there has been a walk through over the land by the locals, is this no longer the case? Alterations have been made to the roof height this we feel is having an impact on the neighbouring property amenities.

The Parish Council agrees with the comments make by the highway development management and that access should be taken from West End also that amended details of vehicle and pedestrian access should be provided.

For these reasons we believe amended plans should be resubmitted.
