In relation to the removal of the previous traffic island was based on the decision that there are no continuous footpath links in the location of junction and also that there was significant vehicle overrun damage to both the island and the junction radius as there was insufficient space for larger vehicles to negotiate the junction.</i> The footpath off Driffield Road has been reopened.
